
¹¹ The Lord said, (to Elijah) "Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by." Then a great and powerful wind tore the mountains apart and shattered the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. After the wind there was an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. ¹² After the earthquake came a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire came a gentle whisper. ¹³ When Elijah heard it, he pulled his cloak over his face and went out and stood at the mouth of the cave.

COUNCIL REPORT

The Congregation Council met in the library at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13. Revenue was \$182,647.29 in 2019, \$17,780 higher than forecast. Attendance of 4,329 was 120 less than in 2018. His projection for 2020 revenue is \$170,000. Assets in the investment account exceeded the initial investment of 4/18/2014 for the first time since that date. The 2020 Expense Budget was approved and sent to the congregation for review.

Visitor Parking signs were purchased and signs for Reserved Parking for People with Walking Difficulties are being considered. Those who are able are encouraged to park on the grass during the busy winter season in order to allow more pavement parking for guests.

The Congregation Council met in the fellowship hall at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 10. Incoming office manager, Nina Osmanovic, was introduced. Her first day in the office was scheduled for February 18. Pastor Mitchell shared a request from The Steppers to add a Monday evening group for women. Details need to be worked out.

Amendments to the church's constitution and bylaws were reviewed and referred to the congregation for approval. The Mutual Ministry Committee met for the second time following their reorganization. A new riding lawn mower has been purchased, light switches in the nave are being upgraded, and the garden along the west driveway has been weeded and is being re-mulched.

There has been discussion at the Council meeting and several committee meetings regarding the possibility of decorating the 30' cross with flowers for Easter. Logistics still need to be worked out. A Support Covenant was signed with Family Promise and it is hoped that the organization will soon have volunteer churches lined up so it can house families again.

Outgoing Council members were thanked for their service: Sharon Koelsch, Justin Leslie, Kathy Rabey, and Bob Rogers. In addition, Sue Crook was acknowledged and thanked for serving as secretary during much of the year.
