### GROWING IN OUR JOURNEY OF FAITH

#### A New Small Group

## HOW DID YOU LEARN TO GIVE?

UPDATE ON OUR STEWARDSHIP EMPHASIS

Thank you to all who told their stories of who taught them to give and how it affected their lives in Christ. We were blessed to hear a marvelous assortment of recollections about financial giving and in how loved ones gave of themselves in a variety of ways. The common thread through all of the stories was the presence of the Holy Spirit at work in the lives of the faithful, who responded generously as they were able. And in that responding the Spirit worked in the hearts who witnessed these acts of stewardship and made a lasting imprint in their journey of faith.



At this time, we have received 134 Estimates of Giving totaling \$384,130, which compares to 2016 totals at this time of 151 \$396,018. While we have strong record-keeping that can be helpful in determining how much we may receive over and above the total Estimates of Giving, submitting an EOG is always an encouragement for each of us to consider prayerfully how we may give to the Lord in this new year, responding to how our Lord gives to us in every year. Let us encourage one another in this part of our ministry as well.

## SEARCH TEAM FOR PARISH MUSICIAN

---

Since September, we have been engaged in a search for our next Parish Musician. We began by placing advertisements with two organizations, the American Guild of Organists and the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians. We networked with friends. The Congregation Council discussed the position and gave guidance to the Search Team. Our plan was to receive responses through September and October and to begin interviews in November.

At the writing of this article, we have engaged in several first interviews by Skype and conference call. These interviews will be completed by the end of November. The second step will be to determine in early December whom we may wish to invite for a personal interview.

Our Search Team has rearranged schedules, meeting on nights and weekends and working hard as they seek a new Parish Musician. Pray for the Search Team and for Prince of Peace as we move ahead in our interview process for a new leader of our congregation's song.
