# GETTING TO KNOW YOU

he best part of accepting a new call is the opportunity to meet new people, to hear their stories, their passions and hopes.
As we get settled, Pastor Rachel and I are beginning to fill our calendars with opportunities to talk more with members of Prince of Peace; we are so grateful for your willingness to make time to speak with us!

We also want to be purposeful in our efforts to know you better, so we are beginning with two goals in mind. The first is to share in a helpful way the feedback we received during the listening events in May. Your

participation in those meetings was a key part of our discernment for new calls to Prince of Peace, and we want you to see what people said as they reflected around tables together. You can expect to read more about that in next month's newsletter.

The other goal is one we will be sharing with you. In the next year, we want to meet with each household of this congregation individually. And, since making time for these conversations will require your schedule, this is a goal we can all share!

Sometimes new calls begin with 'cottage meetings', which are opportunities to gather several members together and share in grouped conversation with new pastoral leadership. We used this approach in our previous call. However, as we begin serving with you at Prince of Peace, we know several of our people are not present in the local area at this time of year. Accordingly, we need a different strategy.

In the next 12 months, we are going to go down the membership list, name by name, and work to find time in which we can meet with each person. You can reach out to us, too (particularly if our alphabetical approach would mean you'd be waiting more months than you'd like), and share a few good times when you'd be available.

In the past, meetings like this were held in people's homes. That is welcome, but not mandatory. If you'd like to meet at the church, that's perfectly fine. Or, if you'd prefer to meet at a coffee shop, a library, a restaurant, or a brewery - we want you to be comfortable. Then, when we get together, you can expect us to ask you for your story. We want to know what brought you to Prince of Peace, what passions you have for ministry here, what questions you have for us as we begin, and a few other easy topics. It's not a quiz or an interrogation - just a time for us to learn more about you and a time for you to learn more about us.

In the meantime, whatever you need, please do not hesitate to reach out to us directly. You can be in touch with us by calling the church office, or our cell phones (which someone at the church office can share with you).




## CONFIRMATION
